How to get to ICAMS from Bochum Central Station ("Bochum Hauptbahnhof")

For getting to ICAMS by public transport from "Bochum Hauptbahnhof", take subway line **U35 Campus Linie into the direction "Hustadt"** and get off at **'Ruhr-Universität'** after 9 minutes. On weekdays during semester holidays, the trains leave every 10 minutes. At the stop, head right after climbing the stairs, pass the university library ("UB") on its left side and after "HZO", turn left. Head towards building ICFW (there are some stairs in between) and enter the building on its right side, take the right corridor at the end of which you find yourself in front of the entrance of ICAMS.

Upon your arrival in Mercure Hotel, you will receive 2 public transport tickets for 4 fares each, i.e. 8 fares as a whole. Please note that you have to stamp your ticket before your trip or at latest when entering the train. Ticket stampers are at the entrance of the stops and, normally, in the trains.
